Getting Started:

- Start your time together by sharing about your week- how are things going in your life right now?
- Think about the past couple of weeks since we've started our Stewardship Series. Share about any examples of generosity that you have noticed or experienced in the recent weeks.
- Have a group member read this week's Scripture then open in prayer: Lord, be at work in our lives as we seek to be more generous people. Help us notice opportunities to love the people around us in a wholehearted way. Amen.

Sermon & Scripture Discussion:

- What comes to mind when you hear the word "saint"? Is it a person? A way of living? A story you've heard?
- Generosity has the potential to be a powerful force inside of us, but it's at risk of getting covered up by things like fear or resentment. Think about your own life- what can risk covering up generosity for you?
- Re-read v. 6-7 out loud. What does it mean to sow generously? Is there any area of life that you might consider becoming more generous with that you sow?
- What does it mean to experience a generous life? Are you experiencing that now?
- This Sunday, we remembered the saints in our church and remembered the legacy of those who have come before. Think about your own legacy- how do you want to be remembered? What do you hope to leave behind?
